Our Deacons have been working hard to prepare our church for reopening on June 21ST. You are going to find some changes to help make sure everyone can come and worship safely at Poston. Some of these changes are listed below.

1. Seating will be changed to make sure we are maintaining social distancing.
2. Offering boxes will be at each door for you to put your weekly tithe in.

3. We will partake of the Lord's Supper with prepackage communion sets.
4. We will clean and disinfect between services or uses of any building.
5. Bulletins will be distributed electronically.
6. Masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer will be available. Please feel free to wear or use any of these that make you feel safer.
7. We have purchased electronic head thermometers to take temperatures if necessary.
8. All hymnals, pew Bibles and other items will be removed.
9. Our Wi-Fi system has been updated to its available throughout all our buildings.
10. Services will be available in the sanctuary, Coley Hall, Drive In, and Online to help maintain social distancing if needed.
11. Multiple services will be considered if needed.
